Why should I choose in-surgery whitening?

- · Quicker alternative to whitening at home
- \cdot So you can walk out of the dental practice with a whiter smile on the same day
- Up to 7 shades whiter teeth in just 1 hour thanks to the WhiteSpeed light which speeds up the whitening process

What the process?

- 1. Visit your dentist for a consultation. Your dentist will check if your teeth are suitable for whitening
- 2. Attend your whitening appointment (1 hour)
- 3. Wear at-home trays with gel for 5 days to maintain results





What does the whitening appointment involve?

- · The dentist professional will record the starting shade of your teeth
- · Gums are covered with a protective barrier
- · Zoom! whitening gel is applied to your teeth
- The WhiteSpeed lamp is shone on your mouth in four 15 minute cycles
- Before you leave the dental practice, you'll receive customised whitening trays to wear at home. This finishes off the treatment and can be used to top-up your smile when needed. (This is normally included in the price of your treatment)







FAQs



Is teeth whitening safe?

- · Clinical studies show whitening is safe if delivered by a professional
- · All Zoom! products are EU compliant



What are the side effects?

- · Tooth sensitivity is most common
- · Formula concentration can be adjusted to avoid this
- Zoom contains 2 agents to reduce sensitivity: potassium nitrate and amorphous calcium phosphate (ACP)



What causes teeth to discolour?

- · Coloured foods such as coffee, tea and red wine
- Smoking
- · Aging



How do I maximise the results?

- · Maintenance whitening at home
- · Reduce consumption of highly coloured foods
- · Zoom! includes ACP which reduces whitening fadeback*



How long does it take?

- · Ask your dental professional how long the consultation will take as this can vary
- The Philips Zoom! WhiteSpeed procedure takes 1 hour of treatment (four 15 minute cycles)
- During the treatment your dental professional will make sure your mouth is in a comfortable, resting position.
